“The Prime Minister, YAB Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, has said that the NEM would make Malaysia more competitive regionally & globally with benefits accruing to all Malaysians, with their per capita income increasing to US\$15,000 by the end of the decade from US\$7,000 currently.

“An institutionalised mechanism has to be put in place to monitor the implementation of the New Economic Model (NEM). Without such a mechanism, the specific attention focusing on the bottom 40% of the income-group may get diverted. Coincidentally the rural population of Sarawak and Sabah, demographically the Dayaks and the Kadzandusun Communities, are among this category. The affirmative programme of the New Economic Policy, by and large had not filtered to them. The Objective of NEM may suffer the same outcome unless an effective monitoring mechanism is put in place. The government should appoint some members with sufficient background knowledge of the Dayak/ Kadzandusun communities, to be involved in this monitoring body.”
